The Conservancy applied for and was awarded funding to develop an application to U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and the CA Department of Fish and Wildlife to extend the term of the Plan’s permit. The current permit term is 30 years.
- 6) **Wetlands Mitigation In-Lieu Fee Program Update, Kathryn Gaffney, ICF and Abby Fateman, Conservancy.** The Conservancy has been working with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to finalize a formal in-lieu fee program to accompany Regional General Permit 1.
